Moose Gate Key

Being a valued Barefoot Landing Camping Resort resident comes with a few key responsibilities. As a reminder, the following rules apply and have been designed for the safety and welfare of our campers as well as those of the Marion Moose Lodge. As a key card holder to the Moose Lodge gate, you agree to the following rules and responsibilities:

- A. The key to the gate leading into the Marion Moose Lodge Family Center should not be loaned to a non-family member or to anyone who is not a member of Moose Lodge.
- B. No one shall pass through the gate unless accompanied by a card-carrying Moose Lodge Member. This rule also applies to spouses and children.
- C. The only vehicles, golf carts or cars permitted to pass through the gate shall be current campers and staff of Barefoot Landing Camping Resort.
- D. All Moose Lodge rules and regulations must be followed while visiting the Moose Lodge.
- E. Allowing unauthorized persons to utilize the gate is strictly prohibited.

Having a key to the Moose Lodge is a privilege available only to campers and guests of the Resort. It is important to note that breaking any rules may result in having this privilege revoked and may lead to possible removal from the resort.
